Kindergarten - 4	
Kindergarten - 5 K02-Mme/Miss Melissa	 In Kindergarten/Maternelle, we have been hard at work learning and practicing our classroom routines. The students have been introduced to: cutting with scissors, tracing various types of lines and name recognition activities. We have begun our "Apple" and "La rentrée" unit themes for the month of September. We will be celebrating International Dot Day on September 15th.
