o Principal's Report:

Firstly thanks to all the GB Members new and returning members. Special thank you to our amazing chair Anouk Petit and awesome secretary Nadia.

- Staffing updates: Ms. Shaw has taken her retirement as of today (September 16th). I would like to welcome Ms. Maya Johnson as the new grade 3 (English generalist) teacher effective today. We have hired a 2nd spec ed tech Emilie Battinieri to replace Kim. We also have Ms, Anna (Social work tech) and Merrie (Spec. Ed).
- We also have a music therapist this year, Ms. Mariah. In an elementary school, a Certified Music Therapist (MTA) can make a big difference by using music to help students grow and thrive. They use music in creative ways to support students'

development in areas like communication, emotional well-being, and cognitive and social skills. MTAs assess each student's needs, create personalized music therapy plans, and track progress to ensure the best outcomes. They use musical techniques to work on non-musical goals. Common music therapy interventions include collaborative songwriting, recording projects, instrumental improvisations, computer-based music-making, musical games, choice-making, copying and memory activities, music listening and discussion, and music instruction. Mariah will be with us on Mondays and will be using the music room and instruments.

- Our goal this year is to continue to develop the courtyard playground. We have done so well for the K4 & K5 yard and now this will be a priority.
- The year has been off to a great start. Thanks to the staff for a smooth entry. We look forward to the many upcoming events Terry Fox, apple & pumpkin picking as well as the tournaments.
- Halloween dance is being planned for October 25th. We will raise funds for our school yard and Home & School will also support us in our goal.
- We have also started Anti-Racism workshops with grades 5 & 6 with Angela and Patricia. The students have been really engaged and are learning a lot.
- We will also be continuing with our anti-bullying workshops (Grades 3 & 4),
 Social media (Grades 3-6) and criminal code for grades 5 & 6.
- Milk program will be starting up on Sept, 23rd and Merenda (Hot lunches) week of Oct,1st (Tues, Wed & Thurs).
