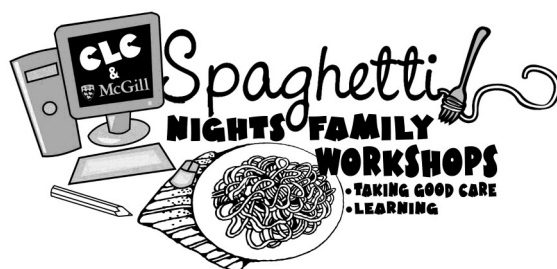


Spaghetti Nights Family Workshops
